Guide the design, planning, permitting and construction of building structures and dwellings in Belize; integrating climate resilience, energy efficiency and zoning, considering the local context and market trends to ensure transparency, accountability, quality and most of all safety.



#### WHY

- Modernize building and residential infrastructure.
- Provide minimum quality and safety standards.
- Elevate quality and expectation of construction.
- Increase Belize's capacity to design and construct modern, high-end and unique built environments.

#### **HOW**

- Customize the International Building Code, International Residential Code, International Plumbing Code and the International Zoning Code to suit local conditions.
- Collaborate with industry
- stakeholders to prioritize key concerns and address potential issues.
- Review and update relevant legislation. Build Capacity of stakeholders and local authorities.

#### **WHEN**

- May 2021 GOB approved use of I- Codes as reference for minimum design standards.
- August 2021 technical workgroup developed to review and customize Codes.
- July 2022 Presentation of draft custom codes to stakeholders.
